

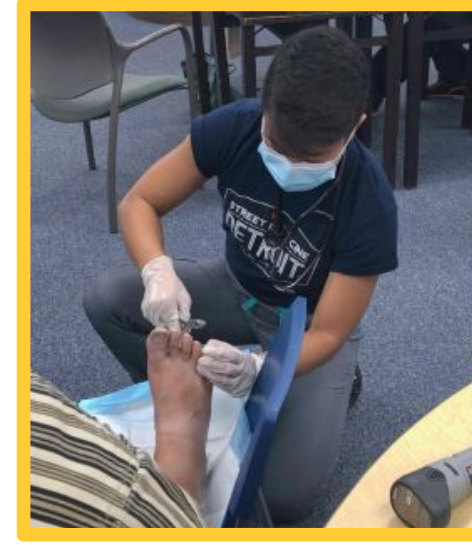
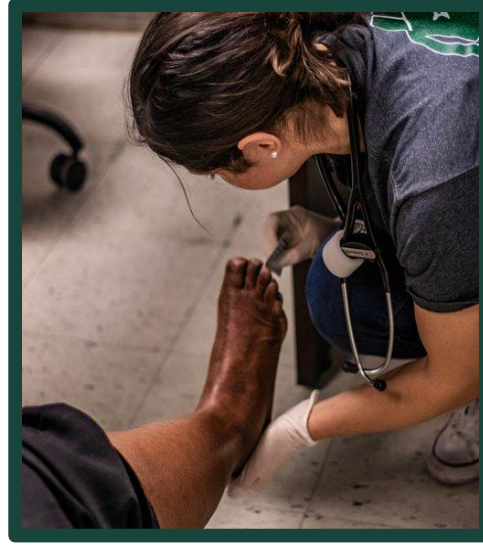


Street-Based Foot Care as Harm Reduction: A Low-Barrier Model Across Three Student-Run Teams

Low-barrier, trust-based, and rooted in harm reduction.

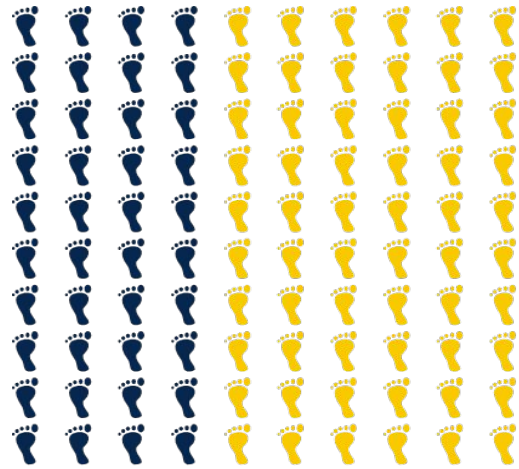
Why Foot Care?

50-70% of **People Experiencing Homelessness**

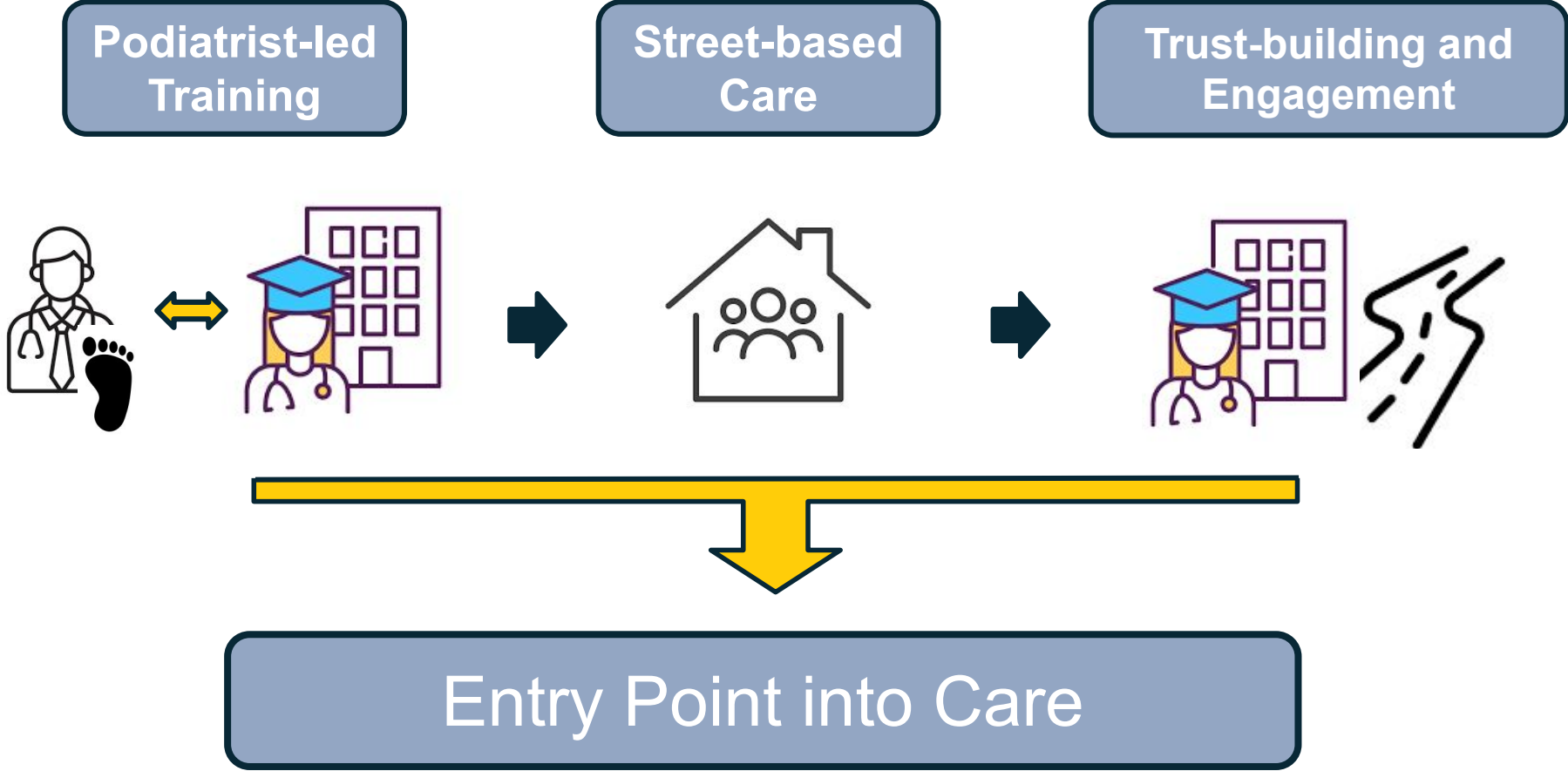
vs.

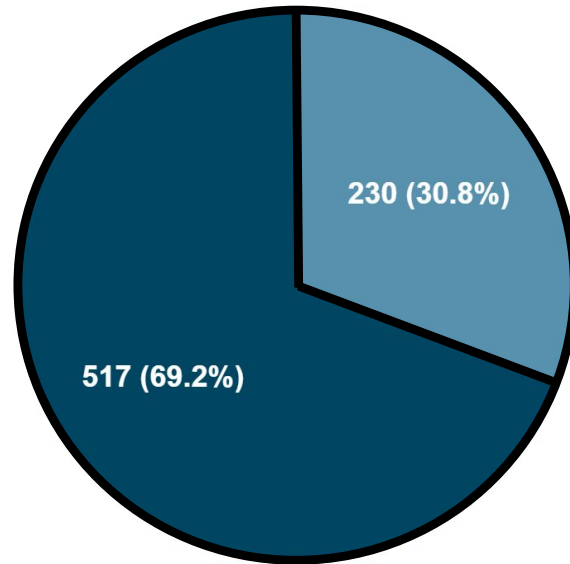
